

Mr.B.V. Thimmarayappa acquired land in Survey No. 154/10, (and other Sy No lands) measuring 8 acres, through an auction on 26.09.1932 (Sub .Hu.No. 33/26-09-32). When applying for the same to be recorded in the Record Room (RR No. 280, 281, 282, 283, 284, 285, 286, 287, 288, 289, 292, 293, 294, 295, 296, 297), an endorsement was given stating "not available."

Afterward, Thimmarayappa executed a Will:

Schedule 1 was given to Somashekar Reddy.

Schedule 2 to Padmakshamma

Schedule 3 to Subhashamma.

Schedule 4 to B v Thimmarayappa and Nanjamma.

after the death of Thimmarayappa the same schedule 4 goes to same Somashekar reddy as per the will ,like he got the rights over the Sy No.154/10, and after the understanding between Somashekar Reddy and his Mother Nanjamma ,after the death of Thimmarayappa dated on 04.03.1981 ,they transferred the same sy no.154/10 and other sy no,s 336,337,338,342(old Sy No.154/10) totally 27 acres **to Gopinath and through IHC No.13/83-84**, and applied same MR to record room and they given Endorsement and the explained in Registered Partition Deed Doc No.933/2002-2003 dated :26.04.2002,

Afterward, Mr. Gopinath executed 4 Sale deeds in Sy No.342 measuring 8 acres :

- Doc No.444/95-96 1 acre to Appanna Reddy and afterthat the new no is 342/2.
- Doc No.418/95-96 1 acre to Thulasamma and afterthat the new no is 342/3.
- Doc No.417/95-96 1 acre to Appanna Reddy and afterthat the new no is 342/4.
- Doc No.445/95-96 1 acre to Thulasamma and afterthat the new no is 342/5.

Balance 4 Acres retained by Gopinath and the new no is 342/1.
